Levente Kuzma appeared as a featured artist at notable venues all around Europe, UK, Russia and the USA. He is prizewinner of several international organ competitions as: Organi Storici del Basso Friuli in Muzzana del Turgnano in 2009; International Organ Competition Vicenza in 2010; and The Alexander Goedicke International Organ Competition in Moscow in 2011. He earned the First Place in the „Timorgelfest” International Organ Competition Timisoara (Romania) in 2009. He currently serves as music director at the Piarist Church in Szeged. and also serves as principal of Lieto “School of Music and Arts. Since September 2018, he is professor of organ at the University of Szeged and, in addition, he is the Artistic Director of the at the Cathedral of Our Lady in Szeged. His debut solo album „Masterworks, was released in 2017 on the Waltman’s Artists (UK).
