



TERRA SANCTA ORGAN FESTIVAL 2023-2024 Spring concerts in Lebanon and Syria 12 April – 1 May 2024 Press release

From April 12 to May 1, the Terra Sancta Organ Festival presents nineteen concerts in Lebanon and Syria. Organized by the Custody of the Holy Land as an artistic contribution to the culture of the countries where it is present

(Israel, Palestine, Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, Greece, Cyprus, Egypt), since 2014 the Terra Sancta Organ Festival is often the only opportunity to listen the repertoire of the largest of musical instruments in the Middle East and the Levant. All information can be found on the website www.tsorganfestival.org. The Terra Sancta Organ Festival also has a popular YouTube channel with 275 videos taken from its concerts and a Facebook page.

The festival takes on different names depending on the places and partners, although it presents itself with its own name in a single general program. In Lebanon the concerts are organized together with Notre Dame University and give rise to the "Lebanese Organ Week" (SOL Festival, acronym for Semaine de l'Orgue au Liban) with the collaboration of the Italian Cultural Institute of Beirut and the support of the embassies of the countries of origin of the foreign musicians (this year Germany, Spain, as well as Italy). Ten concerts will be held in Lebanon from 12 to 21 April, covering the country in its entire extension, from north to south, from Tripoli to Tyre, through Mount Lebanon, Beirut and up to the Beqaa valley. The program includes an organ concert with the Lebanese Philharmonic Orchestra, one with organ and vocal ensemble, two concerts with improvisation on silent film, a "cross-art" performance with prepared piano, organ, poetry and live painting, three concerts of chamber music and two solo organ recitals. In Syria, the festival is called "Organ & Music Festival Syria" and is organized in collaboration with the Damascus Opera House and the Higher Institute of Music. In addition to the Damascus Opera House and the National Conservatory, concerts take place in churches in Damascus, Aleppo and Latakia. The foreign musicians come from Italy, Spain and Austria. The program highlights the organ concert with the Syrian National Symphony Orchestra, two concerts with improvisation on silent film, a "cross-art" performance with prepared piano, organ, dance and percussion, other chamber ensembles and two essays from the master classes.
